Better Black and White Photography with a Digital Camera

Taking black and white photographs with a digital camera is easy. Taking high quality black and white photographs with your digital camera is an entirely different matter. Those who come from a film background realize that there are many, many variables. Using different films, printing papers, filters, or processing techniques can produce very different results. With digital photography you take control on the computer, your digital darkroom. This workshop will explore some of the techniques you can use to create better black and white photographs from your digital files.

Getting Started with Digital Photography

(These two workshops are scheduled for the same day, Part 1 in the morning and Part 2 in the afternoon, to allow an individual to take either or both.)

Part 1: The Digital Camera

Digital and film cameras perform the same basic function, they capture light as a two dimensional image. How they capture that light is where the difference lies. We will begin with an introduction to how digital cameras work. This will provide the background for an in-depth look at the capabilities of the many different types of digital cameras on the market with the goal of helping you decide which type is best for you.

Part 2: Taking Control of Your Adjustable Digital Camera

The subtitle for this workshop could be: *Turning Off Auto Exposure*. Shutter speed, aperture, and ISO are the three factors that determine the exposure of a photograph. Since each of these three factors has different effects on the results, if you leave the camera set to auto, you are relinquishing creative control to the person who programmed the software in the camera. This session will also include a discussion of the various file formats for saving your images and the advantages and disadvantages of each.

What to bring: If you have an adjustable digital camera, one with exposure modes that includes manual exposure, bring it and the camera's instruction manual with you.

Basic Sign, hand and finger combinations, also includes facial expression and body movements. Students will learn and study both at an introductory level. Participants will learn who, what, when, where, why and how, enabling them to assist the deaf as needed. Learning Sign Language and Finger Spelling is fun! As with any second language, practice is important and constant visual observation is a necessity.

Alec and Penny Craig will teach this class together. **Alec** worked for 28 years in Special Education as a classroom teacher and college professor. He taught Basic Sign and Finger Spelling in his courses as a college professor. He was able to assist deaf customers at both Publix and Salvation Army when he was working there. **Penny** is a teacher and has studied Basic Sign Language. She has taught Adult Education classes in Basic Sign. While living in Maine, she taught a Basic Sign class to school employees
